With your LSAT Self-Paced Course, you have oodles of resources at your disposal to achieve LSAT glory. You may be asking yourself, “How can I best use all this to maximize my LSAT score?” Behold... **the Pacing Guide!**

We have found that the students that have the largest score increases tend to complete **2,500** test questions through a combination of practice exams and Qbank questions. As such, we set a goal for you to complete **8 Blueprint Practice Exams and 1,700 practice questions** in your Blueprint account. You also have **69 learning modules** that show you the ins & outs of all things LSAT. It is imperative that you utilize these modules, complete practice questions & exams, and review your work & concepts along the way. Doing so will give you the best preparation for the LSAT.

This table outlines how you can accomplish these goals. The course is broken into 15 “**blocks**”, each with several learning modules, practice sets, and (mostly later in the course) practice exams. The running totals show how many modules and questions you should have completed after working through all of the coursework for each block. **Generally, you can expect to spend around 12-18 hours to complete each block**, including time to review your work.

Learning Modules

Each block contains 3-6 learning modules. Each module contains video instruction by our LSAT experts that break each concept on the LSAT down into understandable, digestible chunks. But it's not just video; quizzes are mixed in throughout to ensure your understanding along the way. These modules are listed in **numerical order** on the **Resources page** of your Blueprint LSAT account, and they also appear in your **Personalized Study Plan** in the same order they appear on this table. So you can reference this table to track your work, but go through the Study Plan in order, and you'll have everything covered.

Practice Sets

Mastering the LSAT is all about gaining experience and developing skill. To that end, we set a goal of completing **1,700 real LSAT questions** in the form of **practice sets**. It may seem like a lot, but building an intuitive foundation first is the best way to intuitively tackle questions on test day. These practice sets come in **two forms**:

Pre-generated Homework Sets.

These homework sets appear fully formed in your Study Plan following each set of learning modules, and they draw from our expansive **Qbank** (over 7000 real LSAT questions). Each set gives you practice in the types of questions that the modules teach you. As you progress through the course, more and more of these sets will reinforce earlier concepts & combine more question types, getting you ever closer to test-day ready.

Additional Blank Qbank sets. Only you know the areas you need more practice on. Thus, about 25% of your practice will come in the form of self-directed Qbank sets. You will see these blank Qbank sets in your Study Plan & can customize them from there. You can also go to the **Qbank page** of your account to create more. Tailoring your experience to your own strengths and weaknesses is a crucial part of maximizing your LSAT score.

Practice Exams

Although you will start your course with a diagnostic exam & take another about halfway through, most of the **8 practice exams** you complete should be done later in the course, since you'll need lots of untimed practice first to build a foundation necessary for LSAT success. We recommend taking **three full exams in the final four blocks**. In addition, you should also do **individual timed sections** of real practice tests as well. These 12 timed sections are mixed into Blocks 11-15, giving you a chance to adjust to test pace and discover where you can improve as you make that adjustment. Mixing fast practice (timed sections, full exams) and slow practice (review, untimed work, refining technique) will give you the polish you need to master both accuracy and timing as test day approaches.
